Clarification in respect of project to be implemented by line departments.

Sir,

Apropos you letter under reference I would like to clarify the following points in relation to the projects to be implemented by different line departments as PIA in convergence with MGNREGS:

- The schemes proposed by the line departments for implementation are to be placed in the Gram 1 Sansad meetings for acceptance.
- The schemes are to be included in the shelf of projects prepared by the Gram Panchayats 2 - concerned. Since there are chances of non-inclusion in the original shelf of projects subsequent revision may also be considered.
- Ideally the scheme should be contemplated in such a way that MGNREGS provides labour 3 whereas material cost is borne by the line department. However, as per MGNREGA guideline up to 40 per cent of the total project cost out of MGNREGS fund can also be provided to the line department for implementation such schemes.
- Supervision support has to be extended by the department taking up the scheme. 4
- Only Job Card holders can be engaged as unskilled labourers.
- No contractor can be engaged in the implementation of MGNREGS. 6
- No machine can be used in implementation of MGNREGS. 7
- Regular online MIS entry must be ensured. 8
- If the departmental scheme has component beyond those covered by MGNREGS fund there may be a two part scheme, the first part (Part-A) concerns MGNREGS funded scheme and the second part (Part-B) should cover the departmentally funded part of the larger scheme.
- Schemes implemented by the departments are also part of the social audit process and hence 10 data should be made available to concern authority as and when required.

Kindly inform all the line departments in your districts to propose schemes in convergence with MGNREGS by following the above noted points.
